

## POINTS TO REMEMBER FOR TEACHERS

- 1. Cover the table or mat with plastic sheet or an old newspaper.
- 2. Collect all the materials and equipments you need before the activity and put them on the table or mat.
- 3. Protect your children clothes by wearing apron.
- 4. Roll up your and children sleeves.
- 5. The demonstration of the activity should be visible for all the children.
- 6. Before starting the activity motivate the children so that they may get involved.
- 7. Introduce the activity which you are going to perform, e.g. if you are crafting a lion mask so introduce and show them the picture of a lion first.
- 8. Do the activity step by step with children; make sure every child is following your instructions.
- 9. Your instructions should be very clear and simple so that children might understand easily.
- 10. Make sure children are not using any sharp edged material like cutter or pointed scissor etc. these materials can only be used by teachers.
- 11. Give children round shape scissors
- 12. If the cutting work is difficult, too much or consists of tiny objects, the teacher must cut before the activity in her free time for all children.
- 13. Help the child when it is required otherwise do not interfere, just observe.
- 14. Help children for folding if required.
- 15. Always use transparent glue.
- 16. Teacher should keep patience during the activity as children do work slowly.
- 17. After the activity, guide the children to wash their hands with soap and put all the material back to its place.
- 18. Appreciate the children for their work by using simple sentences like, "wow! you have done a great job.", "bravo", "superb" or "excellent" etc.
- 19. Wash all the brushes and let them dry.
- 20. Clean the place and things then arrange all the material back to its appropriat position.

# **My Crown**

#### Date:




Take a strip of chart paper 5 inches long and wide according to child's head.



2 Fold the strip into half. And draw a line for the pattern of the crown.



Draw the pattern on the strip as shown in the picture.



4 Cut the pattern with the scissors. And unfold the strip.



Draw circle on the colorful papers with the help of bottle cap and cut it.



7 Decorate the crown with glitters and beads.

#### **Material Needed:**

- Pencil Scissors Scale Stapler
- Any Coloured Chart Paper
- Colour Paper Glitters Beads



8 Join the both ends of crown and then staple it.



6 Apply glue on circles and paste them on the crown.




Crown is ready.

## Instructions:

- Tube Paints
- Marker

Take tube paint and make dots on the half wing of the butterfly then fold the page into half & press it to get the print for second wing. Draw the tenticles with marker.



## Frog

 Take a paper glass and paint it with green paint.



2 Draw legs of the frog on green chart paper and cut it with scissors.



3 Draw the hands of frog on the green chart paper and cut them with scissors.



4 Draw a tongue on a red chart paper and eyes on white paper. Cut them with scissors.



5 Paste the arms and legs on the frog as shown in the picture.



6 Paste the eyes and tongue on the frog as shown in the picture.

#### **Material Needed:**

- Paper Glass Green Paint
- Green & Red Chart Paper
- Scissors Whit Paper Glue

#### **Instructions:**

Help the child to cut the legs, hands, eyes and tongue. You can also make bird, peacock, duck with the help of paper glass.
